



Job Posting: Elementary Enrichment Coach Boston Scores School Year 2021-22

About Boston Scores

Boston Scores is a free after school program for urban students grades K2-12 that combines soccer with classroom-based poetry, service learning and financial literacy.

Boston Scores promotes leadership, teamwork, commitment and positive self-expression among urban young people. We typically serve 1,400+ students annually on over 50 school-based soccer teams across the City of Boston, plus high school and summer programs.

About the Position

Duties of the Enrichment coach include, but are not limited to:

- Plan and conduct enrichment workshops twice a week, 90 minutes each day, for the 8-week fall season and the 10-week spring season for a team of up to 15 elementary students per team.
- Use the America Scores curricula, Power of Poetry and Writing for the Community, as a basis of instruction
- Attend all required Boston Scores training sessions
- Administer and collect all pre and post evaluations
- Prepare students to present final season presentations: Poetry Slam in the Fall and Jamboree in the Spring
- Abide by all Boston Public Schools COVID protocols
 - Wear a mask at all times (over mouth and nose)
 - Sign in and out of the front office daily
 - Daily cleaning of the classroom space at the end of each practice (desks, any shared spaces, and high touch areas)
 - Accurate daily attendance with sign-in and sign-out process for contact tracing purposes
 - Participate in any pool testing done at the school
 - Comply with the city's Vaccine Verification or Required Testing requirement for COVID-19 (outlined in the August 12, 2021 announcement from Mayor Janey). Starting October 18, 2021, onsite contractors, volunteers, and partner staff must provide proof of vaccination or weekly negative test results. (Process details are forthcoming from the city)

Skills and Qualifications

- Experience working with children 7 to 11
- Must have understanding of urban education and youth development
- Strong verbal and interpersonal communication skills
- Detail oriented and organization is essential
- Flexibility
- Fluency in Spanish, Portuguese or Cape Verdean is a plus but not required.



Compensation and Benefits

First year coaches will earn \$20 per hour. Coaches are paid for training and special events.
